- Each essay should meet the following requirements:
 1. Has a title which captures the essence of the essay.
 2. Does not reveal the student's name or school anywhere on or within the essay.
 3. Is a maximum of three (3) pages in length.
 4. Is typewritten, double-spaced, and uses a 12-point font size.
 5. Is the student's own work.
 6. Essay should be submitted in English. If the original essay is written in a language other than English, both the original AND English copies should be submitted to maintain the integrity of the student's work.
 7. Answers the following:

What values are essential for a world characterized by peace and social justice? Provide examples that support your ideas.
